Appendix 2. – Proposal for New Event

Wiltshire Athletics 5,000m/10,000m Championships

I would like to propose the following event.

I have long felt that the two track distances of 5,000m and 10,000m have been overlooked. Mo Farah brought both distances to the fore and I feel that we ought to be encouraged by his legacy. In addition to that there is a very successful event held annually called "The Night of the 10000m PB's" which is very popular amongst UK elite. I am aware that there is a 5,000m event held at the Wiltshire Track and Field Championships annually but only a few turn out for this despite it being the county championships.

Clearly our budget wouldn't be up to emulating the event held at Parliament Hill track, but we would look to make it a localised version!

I would like to propose the following event format:-

- 1. In 2024 we host a pilot event of probably the 5,000m Which if Wiltshire Athletics agree then it would be the County Championship race.
- 2. Each Wiltshire club would be invited to submit a team to represent their club.
- 3. We would hold four races: Senior Open/Senior female/Vet Open/Vet Female.
- 4. Each team would consist of 8 seniors (4 men/4 ladies) and 8 vets 1 in each of the following categories: FV40/MV40/FV50/MV50/FV60/MV60/FV70/MV70.
- 5. In each of the two senior races points awarded for the first twenty athletes 20 for first place, down to 1 for finishing 20th.
- 6. In each of the two Vet races we would award 5 for first in each category, down to 1 for fifth in age cat.

This would then present the opportunity for individual to become County Champion but more importantly there would be a podium for clubs and that is where the USP is for this event.

We would like to provide entertainment for spectators and that would be the key to event, encouraging clubs to bring their members to watch the event, possible features could include:-

- 1. Hot food on sale
- 2. Ice Cream van
- 3. Majorettes display
- 4. Stalls
- 5. DJ
- 6. Street entertainers
- 7. Reintroduction of Wiltshire athletic awards presentation at the event.
- 8. We would aim to create a festival/fete/carnival atmosphere for people to enjoy.

Venue proposal for pilot event in 2024 is Trowbridge Rugby Football Club track facility. Ultimately this could spread to both 10,000m and 5,000m events and we could even put it on a full athletics track at Bath University, Tidworth or Dauntsey School in West Lavington in the year 2025.

Very interested to know your thoughts and would happily take on board feedback and additional ideas to help create an event with an amazing atmosphere for all of the Wiltshire Running clubs.

I am looking for the AVR Committee to agree in principle so that I can take the proposal to Wiltshire Athletics.
