4 Committee updates and discussion

First Aid Training - update a.

RN led.

Noted that the First Aid training that was previously organised by the club expired in Sept 21. Every coaching session should have a qualified first aider.

RN has spoken to Ian Tuckett (Devizes Running Club) who offered to run new training at cost for a fellow Running Club - £20 a person (up to 8) / £15 a person if more. Certificates are usually circa £7.50 each.

We provide venue and light refreshments. 6 hrs contact time. Suggest 7 hr course with breaks, such as 9am to 4pm. Or maybe 10.30am to 5pm on a Saturday to accommodate parkruns.

Need volunteers who will be regular / will use the qualification. Rather than just send out a general email the way forward might be to first 'target' people who do coached sessions (Leadership in Running Fitness qualified - LiRFs) and run leaders.

Chair created a list of people to ask first. Potentially go out to all those qualified in LiRF and Coach in Running Fitness (CiRF).

Also to ask other members afterwards if possible.

Submission of Race Results 2022
