Final results of

1997 CLUB CHAMPIONSHII

Simon Spedding and Jackie Rockliffe win long contests.

As predicted, the new system for deciding the Avon Valley Runners championships produced close results in both men's and women's categories, with the final outcome not being certain until the last of nine events selected for the competition.

Of seventeen men who qualified, the first three dipped under the three-hour total for their three best performances, with Simon Spedding's aggregate of 2:54:45 being made up of 36:05 (Highworth 10K), 1:00:02 (Pucklechurch 10M) and 1:18:38 (Stroud half-marathon): veteran Gerry Fice was second with 2:57:57 from 36:42 at Calne, 1:02:29 at Bournemouth and 1:18:46 at Stroud; and third was Alistair Bartlett in 2:59:34 (Highworth 37:17, Warminster 1:02:53, Stroud 1:19:24).

With 1997 men's captain Glenn Johnson fourth in 3:01:37 (37:09, 1:01:59, 1:22:29) and Ted Rockliffe (1st 50-59) fifth in 3:06:49 (39:22, 1:03:30, 1:23:57), the following placings were: 6 Simon Reeves 3:07:54, 7 Neil Whitehead 3:12:03, 8 Bob Ellis 3:13:32, 9 Les Unsworth 3:14:31, 10 Alan Meadow 3:28:23, 11 Anthony Hickson (1st 60-69) 3:35:32, 12 John Makin 3:37:47, 13 John Bowley 3:39:02, 14 Bob Sales 3:46:10, 15 Tony Bartlett 3:50:44, 16 Kevin Lee 4:01:44, 17 Dennis Mellor

There was an even closer contest for the women's championship, in which Jackie Rockliffe had to fight hard to keep veteran Rose Barber in sight in the last event, the Bournemouth 10 miles, to stand a chance of winning. Although Jackie was nearly a minute behind along the promenade home straight, her aggregate time was a vital 12 seconds better. Women's captain Joyce Field was third.
