
Project Jubilee

Late and over budget are two phrases normally associated with projects but in the case of Project Jubilee I am pleased to say that we managed to deliver on-time and within budget - which was a good thing because we didn't have one!!!

To take on the task we were required to firstly physically break up the books that were so meticulously kept by Stan and his successors and then make a photocopy of each of the 500 pages. These pages were then grouped by year and distributed to a team of our club members, Joyce Field taking 1986 & 2000; Liz Clark - 1987; Tina Vivian - 1988; Paul Mumford - 1989; Ali Atkinson - 1990; Kay Middleton 1991, 1997 & 1999; Joby Hobbs – 1992; Stuart MacGregor - 1993; Tom Frost - 1994 & 1995; Ken Marshall - 1996; Sarah Jewers – 1998 and Darren Wrintmore – 2001 to 2009. With each year requiring around 800 records to be transcribed into an Excel spreadsheet utilising a predefined template it is no surprise that this was the longest stage of the process taking from April through to December to be typed up.

The next step was to perform a quality check on all of the data entered, ensuring that the spelling of names was consistent and that these were preferred names where possible. Do we use "Mike" or Michael", "Rose or "Rosemary". Also checking that times were entered correctly and in the hh:mm:ss format.

Then over to Hodd and his SQL wizardry to bulk load the data into the MySQL database that lies behind the clubs website. Twenty five years of Avon Valley Runners results are now online for the whole world see – and to search (which is the next mini-project).



In addition to getting all of our results online, every available copy of the Valley News has been digitised and uploaded. He had just started running and when faced with filling in the entry form had said to dear old Stan Farr," what shall I put down for a club?" Stan's response was "Oh, put down Avon Valley Runners". I can just imagine Stan saying that - so there we are.

Tales from the "Valley" 5, 10, 15 & 25 years ago:


2006: Tina Vivian was 1 st F50 at the Gloucester 20.	2001: Rosemary Barber was 1st F50 at the Salisbury 10K.

AVR - Wiltshire Road Race Champions 2011

Selecting the **Wiltshire 10 Road Race** held in Melksham as part of the clubs annual Race Series proved beneficial as Avon Valley Runners added the county Road Champions title to the growing list of honours achieved. In inclement conditions Tom Fisher and Dave Spencer finished as second and third runners overall and recorded the second and third fastest 10-mile times in the clubs history in the process. Michael Towler (who holds the clubs sixth fastest time) finished fifth and with twentieth placed Carl Davies, brought the Men's team title back to the valley. Not to be left out, Karen Butler led our ladies team home and herself finished as 1st FV50. Thirty nine Avon Valley Runners completed the ten mile course out through the historic village of Lacock.
